Local Accessible Information Strategies Work Plan 2007

1. Successfully host the Beyond The School Gate seminar on March 15th – target attendance 35 senior staff in secondary schools.
2. Consider further seminars and training events, for primary schools, higher education and the health sector, and on accessible e-communication.
3. Continue to evaluate training courses – target 75% response.
4. Consider ways to raise the profile of the training on our website or on www.beyondtheramp.org
5. Continue to follow up the training course attendees after 6 months to see if they have implemented the action plan developed on the course.
6. Produce a report for the Scottish Executive detailing the responses to the questionnaires issued to the 32 local authorities and 15 health boards in 2006, and include the report of the seminars and training events.
7. With SCC funding, appoint and supervise a consultant to carry out research into which local authorities have accessible information strategies, and how they operate.
8. Contribute to local authority and health board events to promote local strategies – target 4 events.
9. Work with key agencies which can carry forward the SAIF agenda – target 4 agencies.
10. Promote and meet ongoing demand for SAIF publication *Barrier Free Information* (2004) – target 200 copies.
11. Consider development plan objectives for a funding application for the period 2008-2011.
